



STATEMENT OF FAITH

The School subscribes to the basic foundational truths of Evangelical Christianity and is Charismatic in regard to the functioning of the gifts of the Holy Spirit in the Church today. These teachings are reflected in the following clear statements of faith.

The School believes in:

1. The divine inspirations of the Bible which is inerrant in the original writings, the only infallible and authoritative Word of God, the supreme and final authority in faith and practice.
2. One God, eternally existent in three persons, Father, Son and Holy Spirit.
3. The deity of our Lord Jesus Christ, His virgin birth, His sinless life, His miracles, His vicarious and atoning death, His bodily resurrection, His ascension to the right hand of the Father, His personal future return in power and glory.
4. The redemptive work of Christ on the cross, which provides healing of the human body in answer to believing prayer.
5. The person of the Holy Spirit, by whose regenerative work sinful man is born again. The baptism of the Holy Spirit, which is given to believers who seek it. The sanctifying power of the Holy Spirit, by whose indwelling regenerate man is enabled to live a holy life.
6. The creation of man in the divine image. His subsequent fall through sin resulting in universal guilt and total depravity. The consequent necessity of personal salvation through Christ. The regeneration by the Holy Spirit as absolutely essential for personal salvation. The only means of being cleansed from sin is through repentance and faith in the precious blood of Christ.
7. A believer's baptism by total immersion in water, in obedience to the command of God, in Mark 16:15 and Acts 8:36-39.
8. Heterosexual relationships between a natural man and a natural woman within the confines of lawful matrimony, and the sanctity of marriage in accordance with Hebrews 13:4.
9. The resurrection of the just and the unjust, the one to everlasting life, and the other to everlasting damnation.
10. The spiritual unity of all believers as comprising the true church, which has the duty to preach the Gospel to every creature.
11. That all the paths of the Lord are steadfast love and faithfulness for those who keep His covenant and His testimonies (Psalm 25:10).

Our Statement of Faith is not exhaustive of all our beliefs. The Bible, as the inspired and infallible Word of God, speaks with absolute authority regarding the proper conduct of mankind and is the unchanging foundation for all belief and behavior. The Northland School Board of Directors holds final interpretive authority on biblical meaning and application with regard to faith, doctrine, policy, practice and discipline.
