



ADMISSIONS POLICY

1. ACCESS

Northland School is open to all children and does not discriminate on the basis of race, nationality, gender, age, colour, status, language, religion, culture or disability. The school admits learners of any race, colour, national and ethnic origin to all the rights, privileges, programmes and activities generally accorded to, or made available to, the learners at the school. It does not discriminate on the basis of race, colour, national and ethnic origin in the administration of its educational policies, admissions policies, scholarship and bursary programmes, sports and other school-administered programmes.

2. SELECTION CRITERIA

Northland School reserves the right to enroll learners of its choice, but shall do so in accordance with selection criteria, which will include:

- a. Recognition being given to the earliest dated provisional application forms.
- b. Recognition of having siblings at the same school.
- c. Academic suitability and ability of the applicant to benefit from and contribute to life at Northland School.
- d. Assessment of the creditworthiness of the parents.
- e. Preference being given to children of staff of Northland School.
- f. No serious learning disabilities. i.e. Disabilities that cannot be accommodated by the school and require specialised facilities and care. Each case will be assessed individually by the Principal and Board.
- g. Compatibility with Northland School's culture and values.

3. AGE OF ENROLMENT

- a. A learner will not be accepted into a grade in which they are two or more years older than the accepted age for that grade at the discretion of the Principal.
- b. The admission age for Grade RRR is normally in the year that the learner turns four (4). However, younger learners for admission may be considered when the admission age of a learner to Grade RRRR is not less than age three by 30 June in the year of admission. Admission would only be considered from term 3 in these special cases.
 - a. If such a learner is enrolled, he / she will be required to repeat the year in Grade RRR the following year to ensure that they are the correct age for Grade 1.
 - b. Applicants must be potty- trained.

- c. Admission for this age group is on a first come first term basis. The ratio of age 3:4 learners should not exceed 40 % of the class total.
- c. The admission age of a learner to Grade 1 should be six (6), turning seven (7) by 31 December in the year of admission.
- d. Any learner who is 2 years or older than the average class age will not be accepted for re-admission in the event of failing a year. Behaviour and attitude will be carefully observed.

4. CHRISTIAN EDUCATION

Northland School accepts children of all religions and denominations; however, Northland School is a Christian school and your child will receive and participate in compulsory Bible Education and Assemblies on a regular basis under the School's Christian ethos. Furthermore, the curriculum will be approached from a Christian world view when teaching across subjects.

5. SPECIAL NEEDS

The school does not have the facilities or staff to deal with special needs / remedial education. If a child needs specialist care, the school will recommend that parents enrol him/her at a suitable facility.

6. APPLICATION PROCESS

- a. Parents will be required to complete an Application Form for their child/ren which also forms part of the Enrolment Agreement if their child is accepted at the school.
- b. An Application Fee is payable with the submission of the Application Form.
- c. Upon application for a place at the school, the language proficiency and academic ability of all new learners will be determined by a Placement Test to ensure correct placing in the relevant grade.
- d. The parents and child will be required to participate in an interview with the Principal or a delegated staff member.
- e. On successful admission, the official Enrolment Agreement and indemnity form must be completed and signed by the parent/guardian. Parents must also endorse the Christian ethos of the School and parents (in the case of younger learners) / learners will be required to sign a commitment to abide by the school's code of conduct and disciplinary system.
- f. On successful admission, the parents will be required to supply all the relevant documentation and fees before a place at the school is secured.
- g. No admission will be permitted without the learner's previous report card and contact with their previous school by Northland School.
- h. Financial screening of the parents of all learners will be carried out prior to acceptance.
- i. All learners must have undergone all the government required immunisations as a minimum requirement for admission.
- j. All parents will be required to attend Parent Orientation.

7. ENROLMENT FEE

- a. A non-refundable Enrolment Fee per child is payable with the return of the enrolment form, before the learner can be accepted into the school.
- b. The Enrolment Fee should only be paid once the enrolment interview has taken place.

- c. Should a learner leave Northland School and apply for re-admission, upon successful re-enrolment the enrolment fee will be payable.

8. IMMIGRANTS

Immigrants must meet the entrance requirements (see above). In addition, the following conditions apply:

- a. Immigrants must be in possession of a legal South African student visa.
- b. A proficiency test in English must be passed.

9. DOCUMENTS & ITEMS REQUIRED

The following documents are required to accompany the application form:

- a. Certified copy of child's Birth Certificate / ID Document
- b. Certified copies of both parent's / guardian's Identity Documents or Passports (if not South African citizens)
- c. Copy of child's Vaccination Records / Immunisation Card
- d. Copy of child's Residence / Study Permit, if foreign
- e. Copy of child's FINAL Progress Report once available
- f. Transfer Document from previous school once available
- g. Copy of child's most recent School Report
- h. Copy of parent / guardian's Pay Slip
- i. Copy of two consecutive and recent Bank Statements
- j. Copy of both sides of Medical Aid Card
- k. Two head and shoulders Photographs of child
- l. Non-refundable Application Fee

The Board reserves the right of admission of learners to the School.
